All students are required to have a current physical and consent form on file with Whitewater High School prior to participating in any extracurricular activities for the 2011-2012 school year. Below is the information regarding physical exams for Whitewater High School students **scheduled at Southern Orthopaedic Specialists on Saturday, May 7, 2011.**

Physical exams are performed by physicians from Southern Orthopedic Specialists. If your child or family has a history of heart conditions you may choose to see a specialist. Families choosing to use their own physician must use the physical and consent forms from Whitewater High School.

Physical Exam and Parental Consent forms are available before the day of the exam. Students may get them from the main office or from Ms. Hehir in the Athletic Department. The forms are also available on the WHS website as well as the GHSA website. This is a **Georgia High School Association requirement**. Any physical exam on a different form will be considered **invalid** which would result in the student not being cleared to participate in extra-curricular activities.

If your child has not retrieved a physical packet prior to the day of the exam, a parent **must accompany** them to the exam, fill out the required paperwork and pay the fee. Be certain that the following sections of the packet are completed in their entirety:

- **The History Form –signed and dated by parent and student with “yes” answers explained if necessary.**
- **Parental Consent Form – including all signatures (parent’s and student’s), Insurance Information (including company, insured’s name, and policy number), Permission to Participate, and Authorization portions.**

This is a great opportunity for all Whitewater families to insure the safety and good health of our students. We would like to have 100% participation. Thank you for your commitment to your child and Whitewater High School.
